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دکتر محمد تقی ایمانپور لیسانس خود را از دانشگاه مشهد و فوق لیسانس خود را از دانشگاه تهران دریافت کرد. سپس به دانشگاه منچستر در انگلستان رفت و دکترای خود را در رشته تاریخ ایران باستان درباره گذشته پارسیان قبل از شاهنشاهی هخامنشی دریافت کرد. ایشان اکنون استاد تاریخ ایران باستان در دانشگاه فردوسی مشهد و سردبیر مجله مطالعات تاریخی دانشگاه مشهد می باشند.

Professor Imanpour received his BA from the Ferdowsi University of Mashhad and his Masters from the University of Tehran. He then studied at the University of Manchester, where he received his Ph.D. in 1999. His dissertation was on the early history of the Persians before the Achaemenid period. He is now the Professor of Ancient Iranian History at the Ferdowsi University of Mashhad and the editor of the *Journal of Historical Studies* of the University of Mashhad.
